

LTA RULES FOR THE 2010 WIMBLEDON DRAW

- i) YOU MUST PROVIDE A BRITISH TENNIS MEMBERSHIP NUMBER IN ORDER TO GET TICKETS – there are no exceptions to this.**
- ii) You must be a FULL (ie. Tennis) senior member in order to enter. This is a rule from the LTA, who provide us with the tickets.**
- iii) You must only enter the draw ONCE.**
- iv) If you win a pair of tickets, you must use them for yourself and one other person. You cannot give or sell them to a third party.**
- v) You must have renewed your membership for 2010/11 in order to qualify for tickets.**

The draw will take place at 4pm on Saturday April 24th at social tennis. The draw sheets will be taken down on Friday 23rd April.

All tickets won in the draw MUST be paid for in the office before Friday 30th April, otherwise the tickets will be reallocated to someone on the reserve list. If you know you will be away at that time, you must delegate this to someone on your behalf to avoid losing your tickets.
